Furthermore, the Opening New Doors Campaign features the addition of grades ten, eleven, and twelve over the course of the next four years. This year's eighth grade class will have the opportunity to complete its high school experience at All Saints in a brand new, state-of-the-art facility scheduled to be completed in the Fall of 2013. 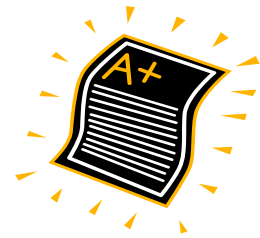
PSIA Dates to Remember

sity in Fort Worth.

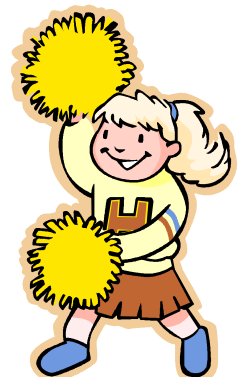
