NOTES FROM THE NURSE

Of continued interest- H1N1 Flu

- Experts suggest parents have a contingency plan for what they will do if they or their child suddenly becomes ill.
- Children with a fever (100.0 degrees F or more) will be sent home and will not be allowed to return to school until they have been without a fever for at least 24 hours (without medication to reduce fever).
- Do not give aspirin or aspirin-containing medication to children (including Pepto-Bismol). Aspirin has been linked with Reye's syndrome, a rare but serious condition that can affect children and teenagers recovering from a viral infection.
- H1N1 vaccine- may be available in Late October. All Saints has expressed an interest in partnering with the Lubbock County Health Department to have an H1N1 flu vaccine clinic when the vaccine becomes available. Watch future additions of the Patriot Passages and our web site for more information.
- Get your seasonal flu vaccine now. Check with your healthcare provider, local United, CVS or Walgreens for immunization clinic schedules.

NINTH GRADE ADVENT PROJECT - "JUST JEANS"
