## NOTES FROM THE NURSE

- The City of Lubbock Health Department has asked all school nurses to report the number of students they have out due to Flu or Flu-Like Illness. - NO Seasonal Flu Vaccine will be available from All Saints this year. Sorry!
- H1N1 vaccine is in shorter supply than originally predicted. There is not enough vaccine to begin providing vaccine through school based immunization clinics until at least mid-December. If your healthcare provider has the vaccine, I would recommend having your child immunized as soon as possible. All Saints has tentative plans for the City of Lubbock Health Department to provide an H1N1 Vaccine Clinic for our students. The TENTATIVE plan is to offer sometime in December. We will send home information and forms as soon as they become available to us. The H1N1 Vaccine will be provided at no cost.
- Vision, Hearing, Height and Weight Screenings were recently performed for our students in Pre-K, K, Pre-1st, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th grades and new students in 2nd, 4th, 6th, and 8th grades. Parents will ONLY be notified if the screening results were abnormal.

## PARENTSWEB 101

RenWeb's ParentsWeb is a private and secure website that has been set up for our school to allow you, as parents, to see complete information specific to your student. You can view your child's attendance, and homework assignments, order lunch, and access to other useful school information. You can also communicate with teachers and other school staff online whenever necessary. All you need is an Internet-capable computer.

Here's how to access our easy-to-use RenWeb ParentsWeb:

Go to Internet Explorer and type in the address of our school website at [www.allsaintsschool.org](http://www.allsaintsschool.org).  
Click on "ParentsWeb Login" found on the home page.

Log in as follows:

1. Click the First Time Users tab if you have not logged in to RenWeb before. If you have, skip to Step 5.
2. Enter your email address that you provided to the school.
3. Click the Remember My Email? box if you would like for the login screen to automatically populate your email address on subsequent logins.
4. Click the New User button. You will receive an email containing your password within 3 minutes (to the email address you entered, which must be the same email address that you provided to the school).
5. Click the Parents tab.
6. Enter the password assigned.
7. Click the Parent Login button.

You should now be logged in to the School Information home page of ParentsWeb.

**Note:** If you are on a dial-up connection and experience long delays in loading the web pages, please select the Dial-up option on the Parents login page before clicking the Parent Login button. This will take you to a dial-up version of ParentsWeb that contains the same information but in a dial-up-friendly environment that requires fewer graphics.

Please call us if you have any problems or questions.

We look forward to your participation. Together we can continue to improve our children's academic development as well as communication between the school and your home.

Parents are encouraged to log into ParentsWeb and check out the features and benefits!

Strong efforts have been put into converting our student data into RenWeb's ParentsWeb. Please take time to review your student and family data. If you note something that needs to be updated or corrected, please feel free to email those requests to Paige McKay at [pmckay@allsaintsschool.org](mailto:pmckay@allsaintsschool.org).

Your Patriot faculty and staff are working diligently to provide within ParentsWeb information that will be beneficial and timely. It is our hope that parents will also use this tool to further Patriot communications!

Once you successfully log into ParentsWeb, you will have three navigational options on the left:

1. School Information
2. Student Information
3. Family Information

### School Information

- From this tab, parents can view the ParentWeb School Home (which is the default upon logging into ParentsWeb.) The School Home view shows upcoming school related events and activities.
- School Events Calendars are available for viewing by clicking on the Calendar tab under the School Information option.
- An online School Directory is found when clicking on the Directory tab under the School Information option. This is a great tool to use to look up an individual family's contact information. There is a Print Directory Option; however, please note that due to a limitation of the system, directories printed from this tab will *not* include cell phone or email addresses. To print a directory containing all of the contact information, you will need to click on the Resource Documents tab. Please note that there is also a tab for a Staff Directory as well. This is great for looking up an email address for an individual teacher.
- The Resource Documents tab houses all types of forms and other information parents may need to print or access during the year. At this time, you will find a Parent and Student Directory available here, as well as an archive of Patriot Passages issues.

### Student Information

- The Student Information Home tab provides a snapshot of items related to your student. From here, parents can see a summary of homework, lunch menus for the week, as well as attendance for the week.
- The Homework tab provides parents the opportunity to view a student's homework assignment. From here, parents with more than one student may view all of the student's assignments or have the option to click on each individual student's tab across the top of the Homework view. Note there is a handy Print Day button within the Homework view, which would allow you to print the day's homework assignment if you have printing capabilities.
- From the Attendance tab, parents can track a student's attendance record. Please note that attendance is taken at All Saints in morning homebase.
- The Lunch tab displays a school lunch calendar for each student. At the bottom of the calendar there is a Create Web Order button, which will allow a parent to order a lunch for a student. *Please note that student lunches must be ordered by 9:00 am on the school day before the lunch is needed.*
- Clicking on the Schedules tab provides parents the opportunity to view their student's daily schedule of classes.

### Family Information

- The Family Information Home tab provides a snapshot of the family information for our students. Selecting a person listed by clicking on the person's name one time, will display that person's contact information. Please note that clicking on a student's information one time will also display a tab to show the Emergency Contacts (EC) for that student.
- The Family Profile tab provides the same information found on the Family Information Home tab. Selecting a person listed by clicking on the person's name one time, will display that person's contact information. Please note that clicking on a student's information one time will also display a tab to show the Emergency Contacts (EC) for that student.
- The Change Password tab allows a family to change their ParentsWeb password.

**More functionality will be introduced to parents through ParentsWeb in the coming months!**
