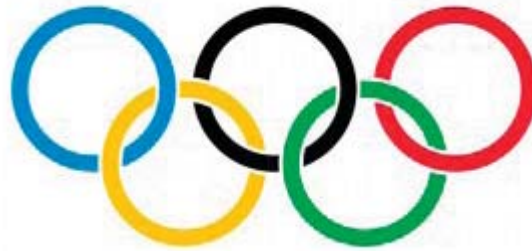

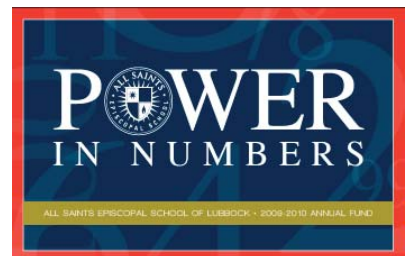
The Olympics are coming to All Saints! Moving Up Night, February 9, 6:30 PM
